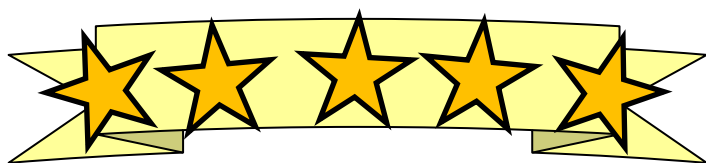
VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

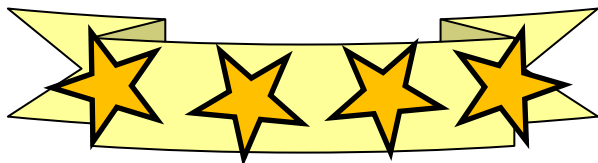
If you are able to stay and help we would really appreciate as many hands as possible.
