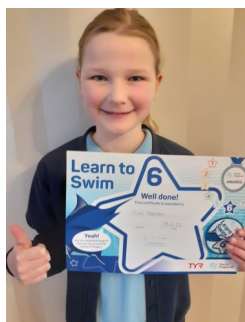

SCHOOL COUNCIL

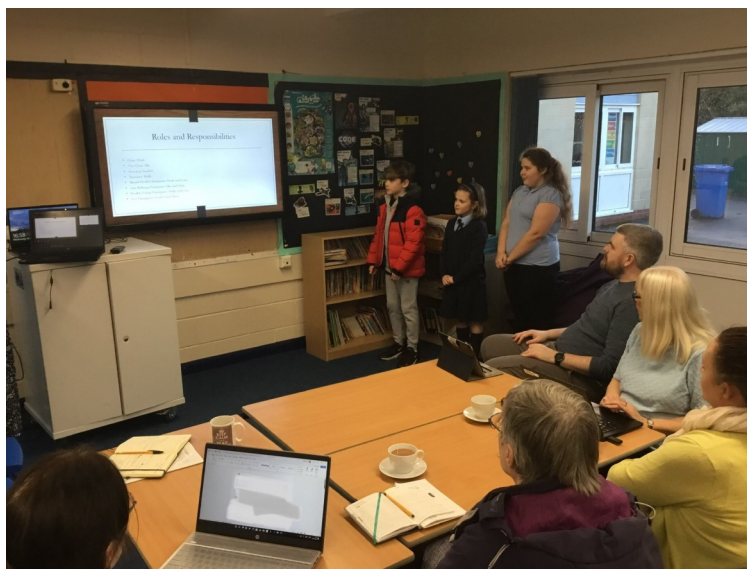
